Journalist and amateur archaeologist Herbert Fothergill was sent to Cairo by his editor at the Daily Bugle to follow up on reports of a "mummy's curse" that seemed to be affecting those who explored the tombs of the pharaohs of ancient Egypt. But Fothergill vanished in 1924a disappearance that may finally be solved, now that a packet of long-lost papers has arrived at the Unsolved Mysteries Department (UMD). This book and artifact set for readers 6 to 11 is presented as a laminated folio containing Fothergill's re-discovered journal; it offers factual information on Egyptology within the adventures of the fictional journalist, illustrated with clippings, photos, and sketches, and provides clues to his disappearance. The folio also features a pouch containing 15 artifacts, including a UMD investigator's ID card for the reader (just fill in your name and add a photo). Here too are a booklet on Egyptian gods and goddesses, hieroglyph-inspired stickers, maps, clippings, postcards, a timeline poster, ephemera, and a Tutankhamun mask on glossy cardstock. 32.
